The map in the book shows the Peloponnesian coast, with dotted lines for Roman ships, and the dotted line is taken to be in Greece. The illustration in question shows the fortifications at Actium. The Romans took Athens in 146 BC, but the map shows this to be a detail from a satellite view, in a section from Germanicus' campaign in 19 AD. Your challenge would be to design a space on the island and create, or find, all of the necessary items and equipment. Which items are key to survival in the wild? And what order and set-up would be best? The first answer is obvious: fire. Without fire or a reliable source of heat, you can't cook, keep warm, or boil water. It's also your most

versatile tool; you can use it for branding, signalling, and lighting. Your natural instinct would be to set up your camp area in a square, but that forces you to divide your space — which limits your options. Fire is a major source of heat. If you leave your fire beside the bed, the temperature will drop so much you'll be covered with goosebumps. However, if you situate the fire next to the bed, you'll have to keep it going all night long. So you'll have to decide whether you want to keep it going or sleep. You can't have it both ways. The advantages of a rectangular camp are numerous, and can be seen in all kinds of architectural contexts. Moreover, you can use your fire to keep warm both inside the camp and outside, whereas a square camp would make it hard to keep yourself warm or to keep warm other people. Fire on the ground is harder to set up than on a roof, but also more robust and easier to manage — and it can be used inside. Another advantage of the rectangular shape is that the sides seem to offer "shade", as the corners are cooler and darker. The "shade" could easily be maintained by adding a few branches, if you were resource
