A simple model of nucleation in amorphous solids is proposed, to describe the onset of a glass transition by confinement in the small space of a sealed cavity of a spherical cap. Such cavities are found in geological systems, where they can trap liquids even after the aqueous water has frozen to solid ice. We show that the physical parameters such as surface tension, capillary pressure, and viscosity of the fluid, and the density difference between the initial and frozen states are the only key quantities needed to determine the onset of the glass transition. Based on the analogy with the classical Fisher-Ulam problem, we identify the lower critical solution temperature (LCST) at which the glass transition starts at a given volume as the temperature below which confinement affects the critical properties of the material. The LCST of the polymer glass is found to be well below the glass transition temperature of the pure polymer.. It is one of the few remaining fortresses built with the Ottoman technology in the former Venetian town of Z
